### Notes for 2009-10 School Year

**UNIFORM:** Boys' pants are to be dress slacks – NO rivets, no extra loops or patch pockets.

Neither boys nor girls are allowed to add accessories to the uniform. This includes items such as buttons, pins, chains, ribbons, etc.

**NON-UNIFORM:** When shorts are worn for dress-down days, they must be no shorter than mid-thigh length. This applies to boys and girls in MS & US especially. Camouflage attire **IS** permitted for 2009-10.
